ORDINANCE NO 48 SERIES 1916

AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING SECTION NO.1 OF ORDINANCE NO 32, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE, REGULATING THE SPEED OF AUTOMOBILES, MOTOR VEHICLES, MOTORCYCLES, OR ANY VEHICLES USING GASOLINE AS MOTIVE POWER. APPROVED APRIL 21ST 1914.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOSTINE, OREGON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section One, of Ordinance No. 32, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

That no person, driver, or operator in charge of any Automobile, Motor Vehicle, Motorcycle, or any vehicle using gasoline as motive power, or any street or streets within the corporate limits of Lostine, Willowa, Oregon, shall drive, operate or move, or permit the same to be driven, operated or moved as a rate of speed to exceed fifteen miles per hour.

SECTION 2. That inasmuch as there is urgent necessity for the immediate Health, Peace and Safety and Good Morals of the inhabitants of said City, an Emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage by the Common Council and it's approval by the Mayor.
